BUILT FOR PURPOSE

Dental Works opened in May 2005 and is a modern, purpose-built, five-surgery practice conveniently and centrally located on the ground floor of Central Milton Keynes railway station buildings, with ample parking just minutes away.

The practice also has two reception halls, a central sterilisation room, X-ray room, recovery room for patients after IV sedation, and separate disabled male and female toilets. The practice has state-of-the-art equipment including digital X-rays, intra oral camera, DVD goggles for

nervous patients, and Cerec 3D. The surgeries are spacious, with separate consultation areas away from the dental chair where dentist and patient can discuss treatment plans. These areas are extremely popular among nervous patients who find sitting away from drills and injections during their initial consultation, incredibility reassuring. Two surgeries have ramps for wheelchair access.

In addition to Dr Naseem, there are four full-time associates, a sedationist, an anesthetist/sedationist, implantologist and a visiting facial and cosmetic surgeon. All associates and members of the working team work together to provide a high standard of service. Its comprehensive treatment plans are tailored to individual needs and desires.

The practice has been specially designed to create a modern relaxing atmosphere that contributes to a pleasant experience. All five surgeries are light and spacious, with two of them also providing complete wheelchair access.

COSMETIC TREATMENT

Zoom!

Zoom! is a bleaching process that lightens discoloration of enamel and dentin. It is clinically proven to whiten your teeth an average of eight shades in one hour or six shades in a weekend.

■ Cerec 3D

Allows dentists to quickly restore damaged teeth with natural-coloured ceramic fillings. The whole process takes about one hour.

■ Intra oral camera

A tiny TV camera that is used to view tissues of the mouth, to aid diagnosis and to give patients an internal view of their mouth on a monitor.

■ Intravenous (IV) sedation

Drugs are used to produce a state of relaxation. IV sedation is a safe, precise, and effective technique for management of moderate to severe levels of dental fear.

■ The Wand (Pain-Free Injections)

A revolutionary new computer-controlled local anaesthesia injection system that gives a more comfortable and effective anaesthetic delivery. If you are nervous of injections, The Wand allows a more comfortable way of numbing teeth.

■ Cosmetic Jet Wash

A revolutionary new way of cleaning teeth with water and air. It particularly benefits those with extensive nicotine-, wine- and food-stained teeth.

Implants

Titanium root replacements fuse with the jaw bone. Once complete, a crown can be placed over the titanium root to give a natural looking tooth – the best way to replace single teeth.

■ Snoring appliances

A simple device that brings the lower jaw forward while sleeping, so allowing free movement of air in the windpipe and in turn eliminating snoring.

■ Digital X-rays

They are extremely precise and reduce exposure to radiation by up to 90%.

■ DVD goggles

While the dentist works, patients watch films on a set of goggles to alleviate apprehension.

PREVENTIVE MEASURES


Shahzad Naseem, principal dentist at Dental Works in Milton Keynes shares his expert advice on preventing tooth erosion

What is tooth erosion?

QA: Tooth erosion is the wearing away of tooth enamel by acid. Enamel is the calcified tissue that protects the outside of the tooth, and is the hardest substance in our bodies. Saliva contains calcium which helps to remineralize teeth, but too much acid – often the result of consuming certain foods and drinks – stops this process.

How can I stop my teeth from eroding?


A: Cut back on fizzy and sweet drinks, and if you must have them, use a straw. Use a soft toothbrush and a toothpaste that contains fluoride. After consuming acidic foods or drinks, rinse your mouth to neutralize acid, and wait at least an hour before brushing your teeth. Chewing sugar-free gum can help increase saliva flow, allowing your teeth to remineralize. For more information visit www.dental-works.co.uk or call 01908 696131.
