Implants

Implants are effectively a root replacement. They are made of titanium. Over a period of time, the bone becomes fused to the surface of the implant and becomes a natural part of your body. Once complete, a crown/bridge can be placed over the titanium root to give you a natural looking tooth.

Hyaluronic acid holds water, hydrating and giving volume to the skin. Restylane is non-permanent and is absorbed naturally over time.

Cosmetic Jet Wash

Cosmetic jet washing, is a revolutionary new way of cleaning teeth and uses completely different equipment to the conventional scaling. We use a jet of water and air jet to clean your teeth so all your stains disappear instantly. It is an extremely painless procedure.

Snoring Appliances

A snoring appliance is a simple device made up of acrylic that brings your lower jaw forward while sleeping thereby allowing the free movement of air in your windpipe and in turn eliminating snoring.

Intra Oral Camera

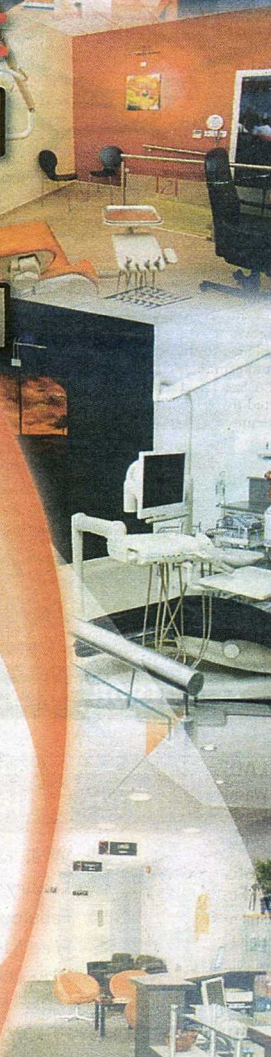
Intra oral camera is a tiny TV camera used to view tissues of the mouth, to aid diagnosis and to also able patients to internally view their mouths on a monitor.
